If a competitor breaks his line while setting the hook or retrieving a fish, he is allowed to make an attempt with the rod being used or by hand to secure the line and land the fish to be counted as legal. He may NOT hook th line with another lure, rod and reel, or other device. If a competitor loses his rod and reel while landing a bass he MAY use another rod and reel to retrieve the lost outfit. If that rod and reel is verified to be the lost outfit that bass may be landed and counted as a legal fish. Anyone guilty o snatching or snagging visible fish will have their catch disqualified. 19. Sportsmanship: All contestants are required to follow high standards of sportsmanship, courtesy, conservation and honesty. Drunkenness/drugs shall be cause for immediate disqualification. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs shall be allowed in the boats during the tournament thours extending through the close of the weigh-in. Any ticket will lead to a DQ. 20. Leaving Your Boat: Competitors shall remain in the boat at all times during the tournament. Except in the event of sickness or brief excursions for "nature calling", need a break or even a severe storm or other such hazards. If for any reason an angler decides to leave the tournament waters early, competitors must contact the Director, prior to leaving the tournament amust leave the paddle near or on the directors vehicle. 21. Cheating: Anyone caught cheating in any NE BASSIN event will be immediately banned from fishing any NEBKS event in the future. We reserve the right to have a random truth verification test performed at any time. You may not use a cell phone to gain an advantage over the rest of the competitors. 22.
